### Annual Meetings Committee

- **Composition:** Traditionally consists of five committee members: 1) Chair, 2) Vice-Chair, 3) Immediate Past-Chair, 4) Chair, Long Range Planning, 5) Member at Large who shall serve for one year or more.
- **Purpose:** To select quality speakers to fulfill the mission and goals of the Society and recommend meeting locations.

### Exhibitor Committee

- **Composition:** This committee consists of eight members: the Chair, four members of the Society as well as the Executive Director and two exhibitors that have been supportive of the Society who shall serve for one year or more.
- **Purpose:** This committee is to periodically review policies on exhibitors, to review fees charged for exhibiting and advertising in the PROBE and to make recommendations for changes to the Board of Directors. The committee is also to give an avenue for the exhibitors to have some representation in the structure of the Society pertaining to the exhibitors.

### Membership Committee

- **Composition:** Twelve members: a chair, vice-chair, immediate past chair and one member from each of the following geographical areas: 1) Arkansas, 2) Louisiana, 3) Nebraska, 4) Oklahoma, 5) West Texas, 6) Dallas/Fort Worth & North Texas, 7) Central Texas, 8) South Texas, 9) Houston, Galveston & Gulf Coast who shall serve for one year or more.
- **Purpose:** To facilitate the growth and viability of the Southwest Society of Periodontists through membership recruitment and retention, to identify and report the needs of the members, to identify and contact prospective members, to recommend applicants for membership status, and to provide membership reports to the Board of Directors.

### Scientific Affairs Committee

- **Composition:** Ten members: Chair, Vice-Chair, Immediate-Past Chair and six members selected from faculty members within the Society and one non-faculty member to be a member of this committee and Chairman of the Prichard Prize Subcommittee. Service shall be for one year or more.
- **Purpose:** Shall act as a liaison with the advanced education programs within the boundaries of SWSP and shall be responsible for management of the SWSP Speakers' Bureau, if functioning, and make suggestions for various forums for continuing education. The John F. Prichard Prize for Graduate Research is a subcommittee of this committee.

### Strategic Long-Range Planning Committee

- **Composition:** Six members 1) Chair (Past-President one year removed), 2) Vice-Chair (Immediate Past-President), 3) President, 4) Executive Director, 5) President-Elect, 6) Member at Large who shall serve for one year or more.
- **Purpose:** To review on an annual basis the whole range of activities of the Society and recommend changes as needed to the Board of Directors.
